ASSAM POLICE Assisting the preparation of NRC in Assam

Under the guidance and direct monitoring of Hon'ble Supreme Court of India updation work of National Register of Citizens (NRC) is going on in the State of Assam. For the smooth conduct of



the process of updation and publication of NRC in the state. Assam Police adopted a three-pronged strategy of (1) Deployment of force (2) Vulnerability analysis & (3) IEC (Information, Education, Communication) campaigns covering different phases of NRC updation process including field verifications, publication of 1st draft NRC on 31-12-2017, Family Tree Verification Centres, publication of

complete draft NRC on 30-07-2018, filing & hearing of claims & objections etc.

Security of NSK (NRC Seva Kendras) and other processes.

2500 NSKs established in the State for NRC updation process have to be provided security coverage. NSKs were categorized as per their sensitivity / vulnerability and security provided accordingly including fixed pickets wherever required. Besides, office of SC NRC, Assam, the DM's Verification Teams, office of DRCR/LRCR etc. were provided security coverage as per threat

assessment. Further, wherever possible CCTVs were installed in NSKs and illumination of sensitive NSKs were done. Strict access control as well as anti-sabotage checks, manual and technical, were ensured at office of SC



NRC, DRCR, LRCR and NSKs.



Joint efforts of security forces, VDPs and public participation.



Services of volunteers of Village Defence Party (VDP) utilized as force multiplier alongwith the security forces for peaceful conduct of the NRC updation process. They were briefed adequately to maintain peace and tranquility during the process prior to their engagement to the duty. Nagarik Committees at Police Station level were also involved in the

process. Regular meetings of Police Station level Nagarik Committees and VDPs were held. Besides the State Police Officers, local commanders of CAPF also attended such meetings for better co-ordination with other stakeholders.






Mock Drill involving public and sensitization/briefing of security personnel.



Mock Drill exercises were conducted all over the State involving security forces and public to review the preparedness of security forces and to improve upon further. Purpose was 2-fold:-(i) to prepare the forces to deal with the task and (ii) to instil a sense of security and confidence amongst general public.

Security personnel were also briefed properly regarding their charter of duties at different stages of NRC updation process.

Proactive presence on social media and campaign by Police.





Presence in Social Media platform is activated in all the districts. Interactive communication over social media is encouraged to identify trouble and mischief mongers and initiate corrective and counter measures.

Awareness programmes and sharing of information on NRC was initiated by Assam Police. Spreading of fake news was countered promptly.





Visibility of Forces : Confidence Building Measures.

The available State Police forces were engaged for maintenance of law and order during NRC updation process. MHA has augmented the state resources by providing additional Coys of CAPF. As a confidence building measure, these forces also
